WHAT IS SUNDAY STREETS MISSOULA?

Sunday Streets Missoula(SSM) is one of hundreds of Open Streets events throughout the globe that aim to help communities rethink one of our largest public spaces - our streets. By temporarily closing the streets to cars, we open them up to PEOPLE for biking, walking, fitness, fun activities and allowing them to experience our streets in a whole new way.

WHAT IS THE ROLE OF AN ACTIVITY HOST?

Sunday Streets' goals focus on walking and biking, community health, public space, and local businesses. Sunday Streets is not a fair or an expo; simply tabling is strictly prohibited. Your activity should actively engage attendees of all ages and abilities.

- This is a free event. All selling (including paid raffles) is prohibited.
- This a sustainable event. Please be thoughtful of the amount of waste you'll be creating. Avoid bringing single-use plastic water bottles to distribute. There will be 3 water refill stations.
- We do not allow any sort of lobbying
 for a specific political
 issue/bill/candidate (collecting
 signatures, handing out pamphlets,
 etc.). Encouraging people to vote or
 educating attendees about an issue
 via a fun activity IS allowed.

GETTING SET UP

- ** DROP OFF ACTIVITY SUPPLIES IN YOUR DESIGNATED SPOT BETWEEN 10:30 11:30AM.
- **ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OFF THE ROAD**BY 11:30AM.

WHERE TO GO AND WHAT TO DO:

- Check your Activity Host location on the event map that was emailed out a few days prior to Sunday Streets.
- Between 10:30-11:30am, unload your vehicle and set up your activity. Once your vehicle is unloaded, find a parking spot on an adjacent street near the route. NO VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED TO PARK ON HIGGINS DURING THE EVENT.
- Missoula In Motion's host table will be stationed at Front &
 Higgins for the duration of the event. If you have questions,

All public parking spaces are **FREE ON SUNDAY** including the parking garages at Central Park (Ryman & Main) & Park Place (Front & Pattee).
