Home ReSource is an organization dedicated to making Missoula more sustainable by reducing local waste. It's no surprise that they're also a leading employer in their efforts to encourage sustainable transportation.

Home ReSource has a Commuter Benefits program to incentivize employees to get to and from work by any mode other than driving alone in a vehicle. Participating employees log sustainable commutes on their timesheets and each May they receive a gift card worth the percentage of time they commuted sustainably over the previous year. For example, if an employee commutes sustainably 50% of the time, they receive a \$50 gift card. Sustainable commuting includes biking, busing, walking, and carpooling. As one of the few if not the only local non-profit able offering a cash incentive for employee commute choices, Home ReSource is dedicated to putting its resources behind what it values.

The organization has a vehicle that can be used for events and pickups, so employees don't have to use their own cars. They have covered bike parking conveniently located at the main entrance, encouraging both staff and visitors to arrive on 2 wheels. For all staff field trips, they always encourage carpooling.

Not only does Home ReSource encourage staff to commute sustainably, they extend this effort community-wide by partnering with Missoula In Motion's Way to Go Missoula program. It's partners like Home ReSource that make it possible for Missoula In Motion to motivate individuals to commit to taking sustainable trips all 12 months of the year by offering \$5 vouchers to community favorites like Home ReSource's ReUse store.

Home ReSource always participates in the annual Missoula In Motion Commuter Challenge and other programs throughout the course of the year. This past spring they featured Missoula In Motion as a topic in their monthly lunch & learns which are open to community members and feature a different sustainability related topic each month.
